Dear Friends, Breeders, and Showmen,

It is with a great deal of sadness that we will be canceling our Live Sheep sale on April 4th in Columbia City. This would have been our 42nd consecutive lamb sale. The Health department, the Governor and the state will not allow events to take place with over 250 in attendance. While this is painful, we understand the need to keep Americans safe and will do our part.

For 2020 our lambs will be sold in five (5) online sales beginning March 29 and continuing for five consecutive nights at www.wlivestock.com. Please check our Facebook or website for updates.

As of March 17, 2020, the TENTATIVE schedule will be:

- March 29 — Primarily Blackface (Hampshires and Crosses)
- March 30 — Primarily Blackface (Hampshires and Crosses)
- March 31 — Primarily Suffolks and Natural Colors
- April 1 — Primarily Dorset, Dorset Advantage and Speckles
- April 2— Mostly Shropshires, Younger Lambs and Balance of the Sale

If you have purchased from our Draw Pen in previous years, don't worry. Those lambs will be in an online sale sometime around April 11-18, along with some younger lambs. By late April, we may also hold an online sale for rams and aged ewes.

We will be shearing early this week, and taking photos within the next eight days. When the photos are taken, the lambs will be about two weeks younger than what you are used to seeing at our sale. They may be greener than you expected weighing 10 to 15 pounds less than usual at our sale time. They won't be as developed in their muscle expression and body development. However, they will bloom. Just look at the 2020 sale flyer we sent two weeks ago, these lambs will perform for you.

We chose to start the online sales on March 29 so that you can still keep any travel plans you have made for the weekend of April 4-5 and pick up your purchases. You can get in touch with transporters (Aaron Isreal, Bobbie May, Darren Clouse, and others) to help. We can also help make connections as we have in the past.

The lambs out of our new rams are very unique. It is the best set of lambs we have ever had. We have been impressed with their muscle and overall quality like never before. Party Time sired a phenomenal pair of keeper ram lambs for us and his wethers are great. The lambs were so good out of Disturbing the Peace that we have purchased half interest in him and will be keeping 5 of his sons for breeding next year. Our ewe base was already powerful; adding the new genetics makes for some exciting times ahead.
